NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 US Sailing RRS, and will be run in accordance with the 2017-2020 Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules except as altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. MISSA district rule 1.1 will be in effect

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 2 sailors and a maximum of 4 sailors from the same school. Competing high schools must be located in the state of Minnesota. No student below the level of 7th grade shall be eligible to compete. Schools may enter up to two (2) Boy teams and two (2) Girl teams. Additional berths may be available at the discretion of the host to each team beyond the allowed initial 2 teams if equipment and space allows. Additional teams will be allocated on a first come first serve basis from the waitlist after the registration deadline expires. Additional teams should submit their entry form before the deadline to ensure their place in line on the waitlist.

3. BOATS:

- 3.1. Fleet of 18 C420s or 18 Z420s. Boats shall be sailed as provided by WCSC.
- 3.2. C420 fleet may be extended after the registration deadline if either the girls fleet or boys fleet has additional entries beyond 18 on the waitlist. If both fleets have entries on the waitlist beyond 18 boats, the boys and girls fleets will both be capped at a maximum of 18 boats.
- 3.3. Boats will be checked in and out upon launch and pull-out. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching.
- 3.4. Any new damage should be reported immediately.

4. REGATTA FORMAT:

- 4.1. This shall be a two fleet, single division event.
- 4.2. Each "team" boys or girls shall field an "A" division team. There will be boat rotation.
- 4.3. All races shall count; there will be no throw out.
- 4.4. Crew substitution is permitted in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.
- 4.5. The Girls fleet and the Boys fleet will have separate starts

5. ENTRY:

- 5.1. Entry should be made by submitting the attached form electronically by the entry deadline.
- 5.2. Payment will be collected onsite (not with registration form) and is \$20 per sailor. The fee includes lunch.
- 5.3. Checks should be made payable to: WCSC
- 5.4. **The entry deadline is Tuesday May 23rd, 2017 at 6:30 PM.**
- 5.5. Entries may be accepted on a first come first serve basis after this deadline provided boats are available, however, waitlist teams regardless of number per school will be accepted in the order in which they registered.
- 5.6. No participant will be accepted without entry fee. The entry fee is not refundable.
