NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA District Rules, except as altered by this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 This is a Tier 3 regatta. Competing schools must be members of MISSA and ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.

2.2 A "Team" will consist of a minimum of four sailors from the same school. No student below the level of 7th grade shall be eligible to compete.

2.3 Competing high schools must be located in the state of Minnesota. Students who attend a Middle school on the same campus as a high school or a school that feeds into a high school can sail for that high school.

2.4 Schools may enter up to two (2) coed teams. Additional teams may be allowed if space permits.

3. BOATS

3.1 Club 420s. Boats shall be sailed as provided by LCSS.

3.2 Boats will be checked in and out upon launch. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races.

4. REGATTA FORMAT

4.1 This will be a two-division regatta without rotations. Boats will be assigned randomly at registration. Each team will rotate their A and B division into that boat.

5. ENTRY

5.1 Each team must notify LCSS (612-470-SAIL or info@sailcalhoun.org) of the number of sailors they expect to bring no later than Wednesday, May 24th by 6:30PM.

5.2 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. The fee includes a lunch. Checks should be made payable to "LCSS."

5.3 Each high school shall be allowed one free lunch for their coach.

5.4 Additional meal plans for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5 and these requests should accompany that team's entry form.

6. SCHEDULE

Sunday, May 28th, 2017

0800 - Registration and rigging of boats

0900 - Competitors meeting. Mandatory for all sailors

0945 - First Warning. Races will continue throughout the day.

Lunch will be served on shore between sets

1500 - No race shall start after this time.

7. AWARDS

Awards will be given to the top three overall finishing teams.
