NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 ISAF RRS, and will be run in accordance with the 2017-2020 Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules (unless modified by this NOR), MISSA Bylaws, District Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 4 sailors, between the grades of 7-12. Mixed teams (comprised of students from different schools) are allowed. However, we would like to encourage schools to make "True" teams first (comprised of students from the same school), before making mixed teams with remaining sailors.

3. BOATS: Club 420s. 20 boats shall be sailed as provided by GPYC and the organizers

4. REGATTA FORMAT: Two-division fleet racing with rotations.

5. ENTRY:

5.1 Each team must notify of the number of sailors they expect to bring no later than Friday, April 28th. If a school is bringing multiple teams, the number of teams that will compete needs to be stated.

5.2 The entry fee is \$30 per sailor. The fee includes lunch for teams and coaches on Saturday. Checks for entry fee should be made payable to Cranbrook. \$150 refundable damage deposit per school is required. Checks for damage deposit should be made payable to Grosse Pointe Yacht Club and mailed to Steve Balsam. Deadline for entry fee is Friday, April 28th.

5.3 Additional meal plans for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5. These requests should accompany that team's entry.

5.4 Sailors may need to sign the GPYC release form. If it is required by GPYC, it will be available from Steve Balsam.

6. PROTESTS: Tier 3 format for 3 minutes of justice format will be followed.

7. SAFETY:

7.1 Every sailor, coach, regatta official, spectator, or anyone else affiliated with the regatta is required to wear a US Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Devices (PFD) at all times—shore to shore—while on the water.

7.2 Dry Suits may be required. A determination will be announced at the Competitors meeting.

8. SCHEDULE: Saturday, May 7, 2016

0800- Check in and Registration

0800-0900- Rigging of boats

0900- Competitors meeting mandatory for all sailors

0945- First Warning. Races will continue throughout the day.

Lunch will be served on shore between sets

1630- No race shall start after this time.
