### NOTICE OF RACE

1 - RULES 1.1 – This is a MISSA Tier 3 Regatta and will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2013-2016, ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA By-laws, District rules, this notice of race and the sailing instructions.

2 - ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.1 - All High School Varsity and Junior Varsity teams are welcome. Competitors must be grades 7-12. Membership in MISSA is required.

2.2 - Teams comprised of members from multiple schools are eligible. HOWEVER- It is the responsibility of coaches and advisors to organize and register those teams.

2.3 - Scoring will be in TechScore and you must be active in the system.

2.4 - Eligible schools and sailors register at

2.5 - The entry deadline is Monday, April 24, 2017.

2.6 - The regatta will consist of A and B divisions of 420's (no traps, mainsheet bridles or spinnakers). The regatta will be a round robin format, 420 divisions will rotate boats after every two races. A full team shall be comprised of a skipper and crew (alternates optional) for A division; and a skipper and crew (alternates optional) for B division.

3 - FEES The entry fee is \$20 per competitor and includes lunch.

4 - BOATS

4.1 – CLYC will provide six 420's for the rotation and request that you bring additional boats if you are able.

4.2 - Registration is limited due to our fleet size. We may request that you bring additional boats.

6 – SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – available at registration

7 – RACING AREA – if conditions allow, will be the portion of Cedar Lake immediately in front of CLYC to facilitate prime spectating opportunity.

8 – COURSES – will be in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules (PR).

9 – SCORING 9.1 – Scoring will be done in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules

9.2 – All completed races will be counted

10 – COACHING

10.1 – Team-leaders, chaperones, advisors, coaches and other support personnel are welcome to coach between races. Cheering and noisemakers are highly encouraged.

11 – AWARDS – There will be no awards.

12 – PROTESTS

12.1 – Protests must be filed with the Race Committee no later than 30 minutes after the RC Signal boat has docked. Docking time will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

12.2 – Protest procedure will be in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules Part VI

12.3 – Competitors who either file a protest or are being protested may not consult or seek guidance on the protest filing or process from anyone other than teammates and competitors, from the time of the incident to the filing of the protest. Breaking this rule may be grounds for closing the protest.

13 – SAFETY

13.1 - While afloat, competitors must wear US Coast Guard Type III or Type V PFDs and these must be worn OUTSIDE all apparel (including but not limited to splash guards and drysuits) except sleeveless rash guards or school team pinnies used to prevent snags in rigging or improve team/school identification.

13.2 – Every power boat afloat is a safety boat and will assist sailors when needed
