Format: This regatta will run both Varsity (NESSA) and JV (non-NESSA) lines simultaneously.

Boats: Collegiate 420s

Rules: ALL ISSA procedural rules will apply EXCEPT for team and sailor eligibility rules, which are modified as follows: This event is open to any high school team, including conglomerate teams, at the discretion of the host.

Registration opens March 30 and ends May 9, 2017. Registration is on a first come first serve basis. A wait-list will be assembled if the event becomes full.

Safety: Appropriate cold water sailing gear (drysuits, hats, gloves) and USCG Approved Type III PFDs are mandatory for all competitors.

Waiver of Liability: Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host organization, sponsors or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property, or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by the law.

Right to Use Name and Likeness: By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

Food: All sailors should bring a reusable water bottle. There will be breakfast provided on Sunday by SailMaine host parents and volunteers. Sailor should make their own arrangements for lunch.

Housing: Housing may be available, provided by SailMaine host families. Contact the Event Chair for further details if interested.
