## **Directions to the Bowdoin Coastal Studies Center**

-Exit 28 off I-295 (Bath/Brunswick)

- Follow Rt.1 North 2 1/3 miles to Cooks Corner (Orr's & Bailey Island exit) going straight through the intersection,

- Follow Rt.24 for 7 miles

- Turn right onto Bayview Road, follow to the end.

**PLEASE DO NOT SPEED ON BAYVIEW ROAD.**

-Parking is behind the barn

-The boathouse is down the road towards the water

## **Regatta Registration: Registration begins July 15th**

1. Name of school
2. Contact info for the coach (address, phone, email)
3. See below for non-NESSA or conglomerate team registration

Schools shall be eligible for NESSA Invitational Regattas in the following way.

1. All NESSA dues must be paid
2. Each NESSA Member school is entitled to one entry on a first come, first served basis until the regatta is filled.
3. Non-NESSA teams (conglomerate teams or out of district school teams) are entitled to sign up when the registration opens for a NESSA Invitational Regatta. Entry in the said regatta will be granted to a Non-NESSA team after 10 days from when registration opens, only if space is available, at a first come first serve basis.

**Fees: \$25 per school for the regatta only.** (Checks can be made to Bowdoin College with Sailing Team in the memo.)

**Additional Info:**

This event is a qualifier for the fall ACCs, with the top team earning a berth to the event.

All coaching will take place from the pier or the sailing team docks.

Please note that **each school needs a certificate of liability with Bowdoin College listed as the additionally insured. Additionally each competitor needs to fill out a liability release form.**
