Waiver of Liability

- 1) I recognize sailing, paddling, and other watersports can be hazardous activities that may result in serious injury or death. I accept the risks inherent in sailing, paddling, and watersport activities offered by Sail Sand Point.
- 2) I agree to <u>release, hold harmless and indemnify</u> Sail Sand Point, the City of Seattle, their advisory councils, officers, members, agents, employees, and insurers for any claims brought by the minor for any injury or damage resulting from any cause, including negligence, which arise out of participation in these programs. This release is binding as to any other persons, including family members, heirs, and executors. This release does not apply to gross negligence or intentional acts.
- 3) In consideration of the agreement of Sail Sand Point, to offer use of a boat to me, I agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless Sail Sand Point, the City of Seattle, their advisory council, officers, members, agents, employees and insurers in the event of any accident, damage or injury resulting from my use of said boat. I further agree that I am solely responsible for any expenses incurred due to damage, loss of property or personal injury suffered by Sail Sand Point, members of my party or any third parties, resulting from my use of this boat.
- 4) I authorize the program organizers or their employees to sanction emergency treatment.
- 5) I permit Sail Sand Point to use photos and quotes of the participant in their publications.
- 6) Parents, custodians, legal guardians, and all other agents and assigns of any minor child or adult, whether a student, registrant, participant, or spectator, at or near Sail Sand Point property, regardless of whether utilizing any SSP equipment, at any time either before, after, or during any lesson, class, or other event, regardless of whether Sail Sand Point is officially open or closed for business, hereby waive the right to take any legal action against Sail Sand Point, and agree and affirm to hold harmless Sail Sand Point from any legal or equitable cause of action, for any reason. By signing below, the person signing this waiver agrees and affirms that he or she is giving up substantial legal rights. He or she further agrees that, notwithstanding this agreement, Sail Sand Point reserves the right to mandatory mediation and/or arbitration, in any appropriate jurisdiction, as to any and all potential legal actions against it, both now or at any point and in the future.
