1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. However,
 - A. The US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, and 63.4 will not be in effect; and
 - B. Under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 This is an Open Regatta as defined by the NWISA District Supplemental Rules. Open regattas may be attended by active or mixed teams. Mixed Teams may consist of students in grades 8 through 12 from multiple high schools. These high schools are NOT required to be registered with ISSA. Active Teams shall consist of high schools registered with ISSA and meeting all the eligibility requirements of the latest ISSA Procedural Rules. A team is considered registered after they have submitted their online registration, paid their district dues, **and filed their program damage deposit.**
- 2.2 A responsible adult leader must accompany teams at all time
- 2.3 Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 4 sailors. Multiple teams per school are allowed (limited by boat availability). Teams with less than 4 sailors should contact the regatta chair for help combining with another school.
- 2.4 Sailors shall be from the SOUTH region as designated below:

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 Registration opens February 23rd, 2017 at 11:00am PST. Eligible schools shall submit their intent to participate, total number of sailors attending and number of boats they can bring to the NWISA registration spreadsheet no later than March 1st, 2017 at 10:00pm. Additional registrations are allowed after this time, but teams may be turned away if boats are unavailable.
- 3.2 Teams unable to compete shall notify the Regatta Chair (strunkey.sail@comcast.net) as soon as possible.
- 3.3 No Entry Fee.
- 3.4 Program damage deposit must be on file with NWISA prior to participation.

4. BOATS

- 4.1 Races will be sailed in FJs.
- 4.2 Teams shall plan on bringing additional boats if possible.
- 4.3 Boat allocations will be determined based on district supplemental rules boat allocation procedures.

6. RACING AREA

- 6.1 The racing area will be on Dyes Inlet, off the public pier at Silverdale Waterfront Park.
- 6.2 Rotations for both fleets will be located the downwind side of the public pier.

7. FORMAT

- 7.1 The format will consist of two races in A division, followed by boat rotation, and two races in B division.

7.2 Results from this regatta will determine the seeding for Gold and Silver fleets for the March 11-12 regatta at Sail Sand Point.
