Notice of Race

Host: Peninsula Youth Sailing Foundation (PYSF), in conjunction with Pacific Coast Interscholastic Sailing Association (PCISA)

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the ISSA Procedural Rules (2013-2016, as modified by the PCISA), the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING (US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, 63.4 are deleted); the rules of the Laser/Radial Class (except as altered by the Sailing Instructions, or the ISSA/PCISA Procedural Rules); and by the Sailing Instructions. In accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule PR20(b) and RRS 70.5 the right of appeal is denied at all Conference/District Championships. Decisions of the Protest Committee shall be final.

2. Format and Eligibility

There will be two fleets, Full Rig and Radial. Both Fleets will sail on the same race course, with separate starts. Properly registered (2016-17 ISSA/PCISA) teams may enter as many eligible competitors in each fleet as desired. Boys and girls may enter and compete in either fleet.

3. Boats and Sails

Each team entered is responsible for providing one complete class legal Laser/Radial for each competitor. Competitors will sail the same boat for the entire regatta. No boat rotations.

4. Schedule of Events

5. Competitor's Meeting, Sailing Instructions and Check-In

All sailors must check-in between 9-10am on Saturday morning at the Registration Table adjacent to the PYSF Container. There will be a mandatory competitor's meeting at 10:30am adjacent to the PYSF Container on Saturday. There will be no paper copies of the Sailing Instructions or Course Sheets on site. 6. Entry

The online entry form must be completed by 5pm (PDT) on September 16, 2016. Entry fees must be paid in full with the online entry and by the deadline. It is highly likely that late entries will not be accepted. Access the online entry system via:

7. Entry Fees

Entry Fees are \$40.00 per competitor and they are due with online registration by 5pm on September 16, 2016. If a late entry is allowed the fee will be \$50.00 for entry registrations or entry fee payments made after September 16, 2016.

8. Sailing Area, Launching, Trailer Storage

The Race Area will be in South San Francisco Bay, outside Redwood Creek between the San Mateo and Dumbarton Bridges. There is no viewing from land. Trailer storage and boat launching will be at the Chesapeake Dr. Public Boat Ramp and Parking Lot.

9. Coaching

All coaches must be registered online with their competitor(s) by September 16, 2016. There will be coach boats provided and shared for all registered coaches. All coaches must wear US Coast Guard approved PFDs while on the water.

10. Trophies

Trophies will be awarded to teams/competitors qualifying for ISSA Single-handed Nationals. This is the top 3 finishers in Full Rig and Radials.
