- Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the RRS, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules as modified by the PCISA District Rules, this NOR and the Sailing Instruction's. J-22 Class Rules will not apply.
- Boats:** 6 - J-22's with Spinnakers – (owned by UC Irvine). Teams are responsible for ALL damage while sailing these boats. In an incident that involves a Protest, the boat(s) found to be "at fault" shall assume liability for all damage unless both parties and the OA agree otherwise. Costs associated with any damage will be billed to the team and that team shall not be eligible for other PCISA events until that bill is paid. If there is damage that cannot be attributed to a specific team the cost of the damage shall be divided amongst all teams in the regatta. Check your boats carefully upon each rotation. Boats will be sailed as provided.
- Crew:** Crews of 4 Sailors - Weight Limit of 600 lbs. This event is a qualifier thus ISSA Rule 1.2 supersedes PCISA Rule 2.

- Racing Area:** Weather permitting we will sail in the Ocean somewhere North of the Balboa Pier. If the wind/sea conditions are extreme or if winds are extremely light we may sail inside Newport Harbor. The OA will provide coach boats for 8 coaches and space for teams during Bys. Coach boats will be involved in rotations and course management. There may be a small amount of additional room for spectators/people willing to help with race management. Please inquire with Mike Segerblom if you are planning to bring more than 4 sailors and 1 coach.
- Format:** A double round robin (16 Races) will be attempted with two teams getting a "Bye" in each race. Racing format and scoring will be in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules. Specifically PR 7.4. Races will be Windward –Leewards and approximately 15-20 minutes in length.
- Qualifier:** This event is a Qualifier for the 1<sup>st</sup> ISSA Keelboat Challenge to be held November 22-23, 2014. St. Petersburg Yacht Club -St. Petersburg, FL - In their fleet of 10 Sonars - NOR at [www.hssailing.org](http://www.hssailing.org) Teams attending this PCISA event should be planning to attend the ISSA KB Challenge Regatta detailed above if they qualify. PCISA has one guaranteed berth and may get one or more additional berth(s).
