NOTICE OF RACE

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: South Atlantic Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with Savannah Sailing Center

SITE: Lake Mayer - 1850 Montgomery Crossroads- Savannah, GA

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the SAISA Supplemental Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions the latter shall take precedence.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P is in effect modified per ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c).

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. Competing schools must be current members of ISSA and SAISA and meet eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules, and Supplemental Rules.
- 2.2. Registration is on a first paid/first allowed basis. Once 8 schools have registered, each school team will be notified by the venue that their entry shall be contingent upon their ability to bring their own 420 sailboat to add to the rotation. Registration will be confirmed via email, or phone, if email is not available.
- 2.3. Composite teams and Junior Varsity teams are welcome. All teams will be scored for the regatta.
- 2.4. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

- 3.1. Registration Fee is \$50 per school. Registration and Payment may be made online at Savannahsailingcenter.org. **Please make sure you fill out the form online before paying with paypal.** Eligible schools and sailors must register by 11 January, 2017 @ 8pm.
- 3.2. Damage Deposit is \$75 per school and must be paid with each registration (separate checks please). This is refundable if the boat and the gear are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.
- 3.3. All waivers must be turned in no later than "check in".

Note: If registering online you may turn your damage deposit check in at "check in" on the day of the event.

4. BOATS:

- 6.1 The host will provide 7 - 420 Sailboats and sails.
- 6.2 Teams which register after the total number of provided boats has been allocated will be required to provide a boat and sails of comparable condition to be entered into the rotation.

5. SCHEDULE:

8:00-8:30-Rigging of boats

8:30-Skipper's meeting

9:00-First warning and schedule for the day

6. RACING AREA:

6.1. All races will take place at Lake Mayer Savannah GA.

7. COURSES:

7.1. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.7.

8. SCORING:

8.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. HOUSING:

9.1. **Housing is not provided.**

10. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION:

Lake Mayer is located between Eisenhower Rd. and Montgomery Crossroads in Savannah GA. It is on the corner of Montgomery Crossroads and Salie Mood Dr. You can visit savannahsailingcenter.org for more information.

11. COACHING:

11.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area during racing on Saturday, 10 January unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

12. OFFICIAL NOTICE:

12.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802, the possession of which is unlawful under U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine, and beer, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use). An alleged breach of this procedural rule shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when a report is received from any source, alleging such a breach a protest committee consisting of the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA Board of Directors, and the chairperson of the protest committee, shall follow the process described in RRS 69.1(b). If a hearing under RRS 69 is held, a competitor found to have breached this procedural rule shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practical, be removed from the regatta venues and sent home. Additional penalties consistent with RRS 69.2 may be imposed on the competitor or the competitor's team. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the date and time of arrival through the date and time of departure from the regatta site.

13. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:

13.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

14. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

- 14.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 14.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
