- 1. Minutes will be deferred until the April meeting
- 2. **President's report:** Championships: scoring issues from the last meeting have solved themselves. USOC fund 12.8% return reported. Scott Mason will give a full report in April with the 1st quarter results.

3. Bermuda Team Admission:

- a. Saltus Bermuda School; concern was discussed over the possibility it could be a superteam school. They have applied to NESSA and Don Shea suggests that we include Bermuda. Discussion was held over the MASSA or NESSA as the appropriate District. Don Shea will follow up with Bermuda and both District Directors.
