2. <u>District Corporate Reports</u>

- **c.** January ISSA will file the annual report to the state of Delaware.

3. Rules Committee Report

- **a.** Scott Wilson reported that the RC does not have anything urgent for the PRs mid-quadrennial for the PRs.
- b. Competition Season definition: Fall: Sept 1-Jan 15; Spring: Jan 16-June 15. In PR 1.6
- c. Eligibility committee may be formed. Contact Scott if interested.
- **d.** Team sponsorship: teams cannot wear/have sponsor logos on boats, clothing. Discussion of onland at regattas: Page 8 of pdf of PRs defines sponsorship & team support. Send suggestions to Scott and District Director approval.
- e. Discussion of boy/girl separate schools combining and upholding ISSA PRs to not allow combining.
- **f.** Eligibility: NWISA has an eligibility verification form where sailors/coaches complete form and upload a document that student attends school to satisfy eligibility. NWISA also has a home school eligibility form. NWISA asked to share forms/process with other Districts.

4. Girls Discussion

Proposal for consideration:

#1: ISSA Recommends that each District should schedule more Bronze/Tier 2/JV style meets to encourage inexperienced skippers to get experience. Note; committee will create spreadsheet to ascertain current district involvement.

#2: Each District coordinates with a college program to run a clinic/regatta for all girls.

Note: ISSA to publicize events at the start of each season (fall or spring)

#3: Each District should run an all-girls championship

#4: National Keelboat Invitational should have one of each gender on each boat.

#5: ISSA create an all-girls division at the Great Oaks. After discussion, it was determined to let the Great Oaks stand as it.

#6: Cressy will be divided into 3 fleets with separate starts:

12 Lasers/ILCA 7 (Open)

12 Radial/ILCA 6 (Boys)

12 Radial/ILCA 6 (Girls)

Note: the Board will revisit at the 2024 AGM. Allocations will be the same as the Baker

Gender determination for events: ISSA policy should be formed: suggest checking in with ICSA TIDE committee for their lead. C Crane offered: if you self-identify as a girl, then you should be able to participate as a girl. ISSA TIDE committee will bring back some proposed language at the December meeting for ISSA Board consideration.

- 5. <u>Social Media</u> ISSA has an obligation to work with Zim and we'd like to set up a meeting with Sam Patterson and Shawn OConner. We should target specific regattas with photos and coverage. Districts should designate someone to send photos/etc. to Shawn to represent the larger regattas.
