NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the [ISSA Procedural Rules](#) and [the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules](#).
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the NJISA League of the MASSA District, in conjunction with TRYC and BBYRA.
- 1.3. In accordance with RRS 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final, and US Sailing permission has been granted.

- ### 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:
- The sailing instructions will be posted on Tech Score prior to the report time for the regatta.

- ### 3. COMMUNICATION:
- The online official notice board will be Tech Score. The on-site Official Notice Board will be on the white board on the south side patio of the club.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Competing schools and competitors must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 4.2. The regatta has 20 berths. Allocations will first be given to members of the NJISA League. Remaining berths will be filled with teams from other MASSA leagues, followed by teams from other ISSA districts.
- 4.3. Eligible schools must enter by emailing Dr. Randall Nunn at massadistrict@gmail.com by 5pm on Monday, March 18th.
- 4.4. Teams unable to compete must notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.

- ### 5. FEES:
- There will be no entry fee.

- ### 6. BOATS:
- A fleet of 20 2019 Laser Performance FJs will be provided by the host. Boats will be sailed as provided.

7. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, March 23, 2024

0830 hrs - Check in/Registration/Rigging of boats

0930 hrs- Competitors' Meeting

First Warning - As soon as possible after competitors' meeting

There is no cut-off time for racing on Saturday.

Sunday, March 24, 2024

0830 hrs - Rigging of boats

0930 hrs - First Warning

1400 - No race will start after this time

Trophy presentation on front patio immediately following the stowing of boats.

Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board.

8. RACING AREA: All races will be sailed **in the Toms River directly south of Toms River Yacht Club.**

9. TRAVEL AND HOUSING:

- 9.1. Competitors should use Newark Liberty International Airport (EWR). Alternative airports are Atlantic City International Airport (ACY) or Philadelphia International Airport (PHL).
- 9.2. A list of nearby motels/hotels will be provided in Appendix A.

10. COACHING AND VENUE RESTRICTIONS:

- 10.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Friday, March 23rd until the end of the regatta unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

11. PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded to schools placing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the regatta.

12. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS: By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

13. WAIVER OF LIABILITY: Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
