1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, the Prescriptions of US Sailing, the Mid-Atlantic Sailing Association (MASSA) Procedural Rules, the 2017-2020 Inter-Scholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) Procedural Rules (PR), this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

1.2. The Organizing Authority is MASSA in conjunction with SUNY Maritime

1.3. RRS Appendix P is in effect modified per ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c).

1.4 Pinnies must be worn per ISSA PR 2.5 Team Uniforms

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules as modified by the MASSA Procedural Rules.

2.2. A designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent recognized by the school, must accompany.

2.3. Selection of competing schools will be by League elimination. The MASSA Procedural Rules will determine berth allocations. Schools should contact their League directors to find out details on League qualifiers.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

3.1 Qualifying schools will register with their League Director and the league's selection process

3.2 Registered unable to compete and must notify the regatta contact as soon as possible.

4. ENTRY FEE:

4.1 The will be no entry fee

5. DAMAGE:

5.1 Collisions causing serious damage will be dealt with by jury following RRS rules 14, 68 & 69.6

6. BOATS:

6.1 18 collegiate 420's provided by SUNY Maritime College.

6.2 Boats will be sailed as provided.

7. SCHEDULE:

SATURDAY

0845-Check in/registration/rigging of boats

0915- Skipper's meeting

First warning to follow as soon as possible after competitors' meeting

Certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded as soon as possible after racing concludes

Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board at the location designated at the skippers meeting.

8. RACING AREA:

8.1 All races will be sailed in the East River in front of the SUNY Maritime waterfront facilities.

9. COURSES:

9.1 Based on conditions, the RC will determine the courses per ISSA PR 7.7.

9.2 W4 Course is the preferred course that will be used.

10. ROTATIONS AND SCORES

10.1 Rotations will be posted online at TechScore.

10.2 Boat rotations will take place from the floating docks in the harbor

8.2 Scores will be posted online at TechScore http://scores.hssailing.org

8. RECORD of PARTICIPATION

8.1 RP Forms must be competed online by the team representative by the close of protest filing at the end of sailing, or be subject to a 20-point penalty per division added to their score per ISSA PR

11. COACHING: Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

12. OFFICIAL NOTICES: No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chap 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841. Infringements of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during (the scheduled regatta dates) may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1 The protest committee for such a hearing shall be the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA BOD, and the protest committee chairperson. This protest committee shall, at a time and place selected by them, meet to hear said protest, and their decision to impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta, shall be final, without appeal.
