NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 ISAF RRS and ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA Rules and by-laws, this NOR, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

A team shall be made up of a minimum of 4 sailors, between the grades of 7-12. This is a Tier 3 event; see MISSA Rules. Mixed teams (comprised of students from different schools) shall be allowed. However, we would like to encourage schools to make "True" teams first (comprised of students from the same school), then make mixed teams with remaining sailors.

3. EQUIPMENT

3.1. C420s, to be sailed as provided by the Foundry. Standing rigging is not to be adjusted.

3.2. Boats will be checked in and out upon launch and pull-out. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races or upon pull out. All damage is the responsibility of the person(s) at fault.

3.2. If more than 12 teams are interested, additional C420s may be brought in up to a total of 16.

18. Foundry sails will be provided to additional boats brought in.

3.3. Autobailers are not to be used and should remain in the 'closed' position.

4. REGATTA FORMAT

This will be a 2-division regatta with rotations.

5. ENTRY

Entry is first come, first served.

5.2 Each team must complete this form including the number of sailors they expect to bring no later than Thursday, September 21 by 6:30PM. Entries for crew/skipper names can be changed upon registration at check-in on 9/24, but please try to provide us with solid registration numbers.

5.2 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. The fee includes lunch on Saturday. Checks should be made payable to "Kathy Allyn."

5.3 Each high school shall be allowed one free lunch for their coach.

5.4 Additional meal plans for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5 and these requests should accompany that team's entry form.

6. SCHEDULE

0800-0900 – Registration & boat rigging

0900 – Competitor’s meeting
0945 – First warning. Additional races to follow.
1600 – No start after this time.

7. STAYING GREEN

In an effort to reduce waste, we will provide water and ice for refills, but we will not provide any water bottles to sailors. The Foundry does not have a local store and limited facilities, so please come prepared and bring your own water bottles.
