NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Official ISSA Procedural Rules for Interscholastic Sailing Competition, including MISSA Bylaws and District Rules, will apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 This event is a MISSA Tier 3 regatta open to MISSA member schools in good standing. Mixed teams and 8th graders are allowed to participate.
- 2.2 The regatta is limited to twenty (20) teams and entries on an accepted time-priority basis ("first-come, first-served").
- 2.3 Eligible schools may enter as many teams as they can. This will be a single division, non-rotating regatta.

3 ENTRY

- 3.1 A team may enter the regatta by filling out the google doc (<https://docs.google.com/spreadsheets/d/1c3LOx17tfV3NpM5yM4MzPyf-dmgv7RYm8LGTUAcqziY/edit#gid=0>) the Wednesday before the event.
- 3.2 The entry deadline is 1500 on the Wednesday before the event.
- 3.3 Completed team roster, medical, and liability forms shall be submitted to the regatta contact no later than 0845 on Saturday.
- 3.4 A team that withdraws from the regatta after the entry deadline or fails to compete at the event shall forfeit its entry fee.

4 FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$10 pre-team. No food is provided during the regatta.
- 4.2 Each team shall make checks payable to Chicago Yacht Club or pay in cash at the front desk.

5 BOATS

The Chicago Yacht Club will provide twenty (20) C420s. Boats shall be sailed as provided.

6 RACING AREA

The race area will be the in open either waters of Lake Michigan east of Belmont Harbor or in Belmont Harbor itself. The race area selection will be made by the principle race officer and the regatta organizer.

7 SCHEDULE

Saturday, April 7, 2018

0800 – Registration, rigging of boats

0830 – Mandatory competitors meeting

0900 – First warning. Races will throughout continue the day

1500 - No start may be run after this time.

8 COACHING

Coaching will take place on the water. Each coach shall operate a boat that will be his or her respective team's designated coaching area. Chicago Yacht Club cannot provide coach boats for this regatta due to a large number of other programs that the club operates.
