## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1. RULES**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA District Rules, except as altered by this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

### **2. ELIGIBILITY**

2.1 A "Team" shall be made up of a sailor in grade 9-12. 7-8<sup>th</sup> grade students from direct feeder schools may sail, if they have been approved by the MISSA President for inclusion on the school's roster.

2.2 Competing schools must be members of MISSA and ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.

2.3 This is a Tier 3 regatta.

### **3. BOATS**

3.1 Sailors must bring their own Laser and rig.

3.2 Boats will be checked in and out upon launch. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races. Boats must conform to North American Laser Class Association rules. Please bring a class approved sail (red or yellow button in tack).

3.3 The Minneapolis Park Board and the MN DNR will be inspecting all boats for invasive species. Boats and trailers should be drained and washed when they are removed for transport from their home lake to Bde Maka Ska. Any boat that denies, misses, or fails inspection may be denied participation in the regatta.

3.4 Coach boats will be available. Off lake coach boats are not allowed by the Minneapolis Park Board.

### **4. REGATTA FORMAT**

4.1 This regatta will not have rotations. There will be Standard Rig, Radial Rig, and 4.7 Rig Divisions.

4.2 Divisions will be scored separately, but may be started together.

4.3 All races will count. There will be no throw outs.

### **5. ENTRY**

5.1 Each sailing school/center must notify MSC (612-470-SAIL or [info@sailmpls.org](mailto:info@sailmpls.org)) of the teams they expect to bring no later than Wednesday, September 12th by 6:30PM.

5.2 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. The fee includes a lunch. Checks should be made payable to "MSC".

Saturday, September 15th, 2018

0800 - Registration and rigging of boats

0900 - Competitors meeting mandatory for all sailors

0945 - First Warning. Races will continue throughout the day.

1130 - Lunch will be served on shore between races

1600 - No race shall start after this time.
