## **Notice of Race (NOR)**

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024 available at <https://hssailing.org/documents/ISSA-PR-2021-2024.pdf> apply.
- 1.3 The MISSA Supplemental Rules available at <https://missa.hssailing.org/about/missa-district-rules> apply.
- 1.4 ILCA Class Rules will apply; however, under RRS 87, ILCA Fundamental Class Rule Sail Identification will not apply.

### **2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 1800, 10/10/2021 on the official notice board.

### **3 COMMUNICATION**

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at [scores.hssailing.org](https://scores.hssailing.org)
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors & coaches on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

### **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 This event is a MISSA Tier 3 regatta, open to MISSA West teams in good standing, including properly registered 7th and 8th graders.
- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online at [missa.hssailing.org](https://missa.hssailing.org)

**4.3** To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees by 0000, 10/11/2021

## **5 FEES**

**5.1** Entry fees are as follows:  
Before 1200, 9/7/2021 \$20 (includes lunch)  
After 1200, 9/7/2021 \$20 (no lunch included)

**5.2** Entry fee does not include a boat. ILCA dinghies for this event are BYOB.

## **6 SCHEDULE**

**6.1** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1000.

**6.2** On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made 1500.

## **7 COURSES**

**7.1** Courses will be set and sailed in accordance to the recommendations set forth in the ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024. Any changes will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.

## **8 SCORING**

**8.1** A minimum of one race in each division is required for a regatta to be scored.

**8.2** A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores, in accordance with ISSA PR.

**8.3** ILCA 7 and 6 shall be scored separately. ILCA 4 will sail and be scored within the ILCA 6 division.

## **9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS**

**9.1** Support vessels shall keep clear of the race course and only coach from the SI designated area between races.

## **10 RISK STATEMENT**

- 10.1** RRS 3 states: ‘The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.’ By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

## **11 PRIZES**

- 11.1** Prizes for 1st-3rd will be awarded for both the ILCA 7 and 6 divisions, no prizes will be awarded for ILCA 4 registrants.

## **12 COVID-19**

- 12.1** The sailing instructions may specify additional ISSA PR changes that affect the schedule, including (but not limited to): limiting equipment rotations, limiting sailor rotations between divisions, scheduling divisions during separate times, or sailing both divisions concurrently on the water.

- 12.2** Health screenings may be required before entering regatta site
