Tier 3 Event

1. Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US Sailing, ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA District Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents, the Sailing Instructions will take precedence.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is MISSA in conjunction with Culver Academies.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Competing schools must be members of MISSA
- 2.2 As a Tier 3, middle schoolers and mixed teams are allowed. The WI State Championship will be awarded to the highest placing full team from a Wisconsin school

3. Entry and Communications

- 3.1 Teams can enter by registering at the following link by noon on Wednesday, May 15th, 2024. www.sheboyganyouthsailing.com/wistatechamps
- 3.2 Boats will be provided for the first 10 teams registered, all teams after that must bring a boat or contact the OA to help find an additional 420.
- 3.3 The regatta will be limited to a maximum of 12 teams.

4. Entry Fee

4.1 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor and includes breakfast and lunch for sailors and a coach from each team.

5. Boats and Rotations

- 5.1 C420s will be provided by SYSC and will be sailed as provided.
- 5.2 Teams may bring their own C420, but sails will be provided
- 5.3 Rotations will take place between all boats. They may take place from the dock or coach boats, as determined by the OA.

6. Schedule

Saturday, May 18th

8:30am – Registration and Rigging of boats
9:00am – Competitor's Meeting
9:45am – First Warning; Racing to follow; Lunch between sets
There will be no official end time for racing, though we will target approximately
4:00pm for the last start!

7. Awards

- 7.1 Awards will be presented to the top 3 finishers at the event
- 7.2 The WI State Championship will be awarded to the top placing full (non-mixed) team representing a WI high school

8. Waiver of Liability

- 8.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 8.2 The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host organization or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by the law.
