SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by:
 - a. The rules as defined in the current edition of *Racing Rules of Sailing*,
 - b. The prescriptions of US Sailing,
 - c. ISSA and MISSA Rules
 - d. Notice of Race, and
 - e. Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Crew lists shall be completed online for all competitors. All crew members shall be listed and complete the waiver online, or applicable venue waiver. Crew substitutions or changes shall be made by online prior to the start of racing each day.
- 1.3 The OA is Chicago Yacht Club

3 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 1000 on the day it will take effect
- 3.2 Changes to the Sailing Instructions may also be made verbally before racing or at the time of racing.

- 4.1 There will be a competitor's meeting before racing.
- 4.2 No races will start after 1500.

5 **BOATS**

- 5.1 Boats will be provided by Chicago Yacht Club for Varsity and JV Fleets
- 5.2 Any damage to a borrowed boat will be an out-of-pocket expense for the Competitor.

6 **RACING AREAS & RACE CIRCLES**

6.1 The racing area for the laser Radials and 420's will be in the open waters of Lake Michigan of the east entrance of Belmont Harbor or at the discretion of the Race Committee, in the waters of Belmont Harbor.

7 THE COURSE

The courses are depicted in Addendum B.

8 **MARKS**

8.1 Mark colors are as follows: Markset Bots and/or cylindrical markswill be used.

9 THE START

- Races will be started using Appendix U, Sound-Signal Starting System. The starting order will be announced on the water.
- The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal boat at the b) starboard end and the course side of the port-end starting mark.
- A boat whose warning signal has not been made shall keep clear of the starting area, defined as c) the area extending approximately 50 feet to windward, leeward, and either end of the starting line.

10 THE FINISH

The Start and Finish Lines will be the same.

11.1 The target time for each race shall be 15 minutes for Varsity and JV Fleets

13 **SCORING**

- 13.1 For all classes, one (1) race shall constitute a regatta.
- Race Committee intends to run as many races as practical. 13.2

14 TRASH DISPOSAL

Trash may be placed aboard support or official boats. Trash shall not be discarded into the water.

PRIZES 15

Prizes will be awarded as outlined in the Notice of Race.
