1. RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the MISSA Procedural Rules, the Notice of Race and these sailing instructions..

2. SCHEDULE

9:15am - Competitor's Meeting on Patio – coaches meeting to immediately follow Competitor's Meeting.

9:45am – First Warning. Sailing will continue throughout the day. No

5:00pm – No races will be started after 5pm

Sunday, October 16th

9:30am – First Warning. Sailing will continue throughout the day. No

Lunch break – sailors should eat between rotations. Lunch included

2pm – No races will be started after 2:30pm

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any changes to these Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 30 minutes before the first warning signal of the day, on the official Notice Board located on the window nearest the registration table

4. SAFETY

4.1 USCG Approved Type III PFD's are to be worn at all times – shore to shore. Anyone not wearing a USCG Approved PFD will be protested by the Race Committee.

5. COURSES

5.1 Race time may exceed 20 minutes due to number of participants, thus changing ISSA Procedural Rule 7.7(b)

5.2 The courses the Race Committee will be using are Modified Windward/Leeward format. W2 and W4 will be used to signify upwind finishes, 3 and 5 legs total. L2 and L4 will be used to signify Downwind finishes, 4 and 6 legs total. Courses will be modified with Start/Finish line in the middle.

5.3 All Marks will be large bright orange inflatable buoys.

6. INDIVIDUAL/GENERAL RECALLS

6.1 Code Flax "X" may be displayed for individual recalls. It is the responsibility of the yacht to make a proper start. Failure of the Race Committee to make these signals or failure of a starter on the course side or to see or hear these

signals shall not relieve the offending yacht from restarting and is not grounds for redress.

7. BOATS

7.1 All competitors will be using PLSS/MYST provided C420's and MYST Sails.

7.2 PLSS has a limited number of boats available for competitors. Some teams may be asked to provide boats for the rotation.

8. PROTESTS

8.1 Protests must be filed no later than 30 minutes after the RC signal boat has docked. Dock time will be posted on the official notice board.

9. SCORING

9.1 Scoring will be prescribed by the ISSA Procedural Rules 9

9.2 All completed races shall be counted; there will be no throw-outs.

9.3 A minimum of one race in each division is required for a regatta to be official

9.4 This regatta is a Tier 3 event, Mixed teams are allowed & scored. 7th & 8th graders are allowed to participate.

10. COACHING

10.1 All coaches shall be registered in accordance with MISSA By-Laws, Article III C, Section 3 "Registration - Coaches" and must be on the team roster prior to October 14, 2017.

10.2 Coaches may go afloat in the starting area so long as they stay a minimum of 100 yards from the racing area at all times and not communicate with participants at any time during the racing.

10.3 It is the responsibility of the coaches to withdraw their competitors should the conditions exceed the limitations of any sailor.

11. Registration

11.1 Register teams via email to Regatta Chair by October 6th.

11.2 Final Rosters are due to Regatta Chair October 9th

11.3 Registration Fee \$50/sailor is due at Check In Saturday morning. Damage Deposit is \$250/team.
