Notice of Race (NOR)

1	RULES
1.1	The event is governed by the rules as defined in <i>The Racing Rules of Sailing</i> .
2	SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
2.1	The sailing instructions will be available after 1800 on April 13th.
3	COMMUNICATION
3.1	The online official notice board is located online at https://theclubspot.com/regatta/0SoNs2GqG7
4	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
4.1	This event is an open regatta, Tier 3 event, open to MISSA West teams in good standing and other unaffiliated sailors of all ages.
4.2	Boats may enter the event by registering online https://theclubspot.com/regatta/0SoNs2GqG7
4.3	To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees before starting the first race.
5	FEES
5.1	Entry fees are as follows: \$15 420Z, \$5 ILCA (any rig)
5.2	Lunch will NOT be provided for this event.
5.3	All competing sailors must sign and complete the waiver before competing

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1000
- 6.2 There is no cutoff time for racing, racing continues until we're bored or get hungry.

7 COURSES

- **7.1** Courses will be standard windward leewards or other courses set with 2-3 marks, as provided for in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.2 All starts will be by Rabbit Start, procedure to be outlined in the Sailing Instructions.

8 SCORING

8.1 RRS 90.3 & RRS Appendix A as modified by the sailing instructions.

9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- **9.1** Spectator and support vessels shall keep clear of the race course and only coach from the SI designated area between races.
- **9.2** All competitors must wear a inherently buoyant (non inflating) USCG approved floatation device while sailing.

10 RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
