

Foundry Fall #1: NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 ISAF RRS and ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA Rules and by-laws, this NOR, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY

A team shall be made up of a minimum of 4 sailors, between the grades of 7-12. This is a Tier 3 event; see MISSA Rules.

3. EQUIPMENT

- **3.1.** C420s, to be sailed as provided by the Foundry. Standing rigging is not to be adjusted.
- **3.2.** If more than 12 teams are interested, additional C420s can be brought in up to a total of 18. Foundry sails will be provided to additional boats brought in.
- **3.3.** Autobailers are not to be used and should remain in the 'closed' position.

4. REGATTA FORMAT

This will be a 2-division regatta with rotations.

5. ENTRY

- **5.2** There is no entry fee. As such, no food will be provided and teams are expected to bring their own lunch for during racing. There will not be a lunch break.
