NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 ISAF RRS and will be run in accordance with the Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules (unless modified by this NOR), MISSA District Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 4 sailors, between the grades of 7-12. This is a Tier 3 event. Mixed teams (comprised of students from different schools) WILL be allowed. Middle school students will sail with the High School team they are registered with (ISSA) and will attend when they reach 9th grade.

3. BOATS:

3.1 Club 420s and E420s will be used Boats shall be sailed as provided by The Foundry. Class rules shall not apply.

3.2 Boats will be checked in and out upon launch and pull-out. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races or upon pull out. All damage is the responsibility of the person(s) at fault.

4. REGATTA FORMAT:

This will be a two-division regatta with rotations. A JV fleet may be available.

5. ENTRY:

5.1 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. The fee includes lunch for registered teams and their coach.

5.2 Additional lunches for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5.

5.3. Registration deadline is 1700 Monday, September 10th.
