Notice of Race (NOR)

1	RULES
1.1	The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
1.2	The ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024 available at https://hssailing.org/documents/ISSA-PR-2021-2024.pdf apply.
1.3	The MISSA Supplemental Rules available at https://missa.hssailing.org/about/missa district-rules apply.
2	SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
2.1	The sailing instructions will be available at registration.
3	COMMUNICATION
3.1	Channel 68 will be used for Race Committee communication, and a VHF radio on that channel will be left ON in the pavillion (Club House).
4	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
4.1	This event is a MISSA Tier 3 regatta, open to MISSA teams, 7 th -12 th grades and mixed teams allowed. Teams should be minimum of 4 sailors with a maximum of 8 sailors per team. We may be able to form full mixed teams for visiting teams with less than 4 sailors, but we must

	be notified in advance. Maximum of 12 A/B teams. Teams that can transport a boat with them may be allowed in beyond the 12 boat maximum at the discretion of the Regatta Chair - contact us in advance.
4.2	Racers may enter the event by registering online at http://alturl.com/otke3
4.3	Racers shall complete all registration requirements by 1700 on Wednesday, May 26, 2021.
4.4	Late entries will be accepted (via email tellsch@gmail.com) if the maximum number of teams have not been filled by the deadline, additional registrations may be taken at the regatta chair's discretion.
4.5	If registration total is 6 teams or fewer, there will be no A/B Rotations.

5	FEES
5.1	Entry fees are as follows: \$20 per competitor. Includes: Snacks, beverages, and lunch
5.2	Boats will be provided by the MSU Sailing Team, and Sailing Center. Each team shall submit a Damage Deposit for \$200.00 at check-in on the first day of racing. Checks should be made payable to Lansing Sailing Club. In the event that damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided equally between all the teams competing.
6	SCHEDULE
6.1	The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1000.
6.2	No warning signal will be made after 1600.
7	COURSES
7.1	Courses may be set and sailed in accordance to the recommendations set forth in the ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024. Any changes will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.
8	SCORING
8.1	A minimum of three races in each division (or overall if no A/B rotation) is required for a regatta to be scored.
8.2	A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores, in accordance

9	COACHING & SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS
9.1	Team leaders, coaches, other support personnel will be allowed to go afloat in the sailing area during the time of the regatta, and may coach their teams.
10	RISK STATEMENT
10.1	RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law. By registering for this regatta, you are agreeing to withdraw (not attend) if you are ill or infectious.
11	PRIZES

11.1	Trophies will be awarded based on the number of teams registered.
12	COVID-19
12.1	The sailing instructions may specify additional changes that affect the schedule, including (but not limited to): limiting equipment rotations, limiting sailor rotations between divisions, or sailing both divisions concurrently on the water. Please follow on-site directions for snacks and lunch distribution, to maintain cleanliness. Our facility is almost entirely open air. Please have a mask on hand for our small bathroom areas.
