Notice of Race

1. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Procedural Rules of the Interscholastic Sailing Association, sailing instructions, and the MISSA Procedural Rules.

2. Entries

- 2.1 Mixed teams are allowed for students in $7 12^{th}$ grade. Registration fee is \$30 per sailor for teams outside the Foundry.

- 2.3 Each team must notify The Foundry of the number of sailors they expect to bring no later than Thursday, May 16th by 7:00PM.
- 2.4 Complimentary lunch will be included in the registration.

3. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board(s) located in on the West wall inside the Main building.

4. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect. Other changes may be made to expedite the running of the regatta as long as all teams are notified before the race in which the change would take effect.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

0800 Check In/Rigging of boats

0900 Mandatory Competitors Meeting

0930 First Warning Signal

No race will start after 1500 with awards following racing.

6. SAFETY

Drysuits/Wetsuits are strongly encouraged to be worn by each sailor. Personal Flotation Devices must be worn in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule 2.2.

7. SCORING

Scoring will be in accordance with ISSA PR 9.

8. COACHING

Coaches will only be permitted on the water at the discretion of the PRO or the regatta chair. It is the responsibility of the coaches to know the limits of their competitors and thus pull said competitor from racing if conditions exceed their limitations.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for the top 3 teams overall as well as the top 3 teams in A and B divisions.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
