NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 ISAF RRS, and will be run in accordance with the 2017-2020 Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules, MISSA supplemental rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. This is a Tier 3 regatta.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 2 sailors and a maximum of 4 sailors from the same school or direct feeder middle school, between the grades of 7-12.
- 2.2. Any team including 7/8th graders shall mark themselves as a "Mixed Team" both on their entry form and techscore.
- 2.3. Schools may enter up to two (2) Boy teams and two (2) Girl teams. If space allows, schools may enter additional teams beyond the first two. Additional teams will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis after the registration deadline expire.

3. BOATS:

- 3.1. Provided club 420s.
- 3.2. Any previously existing damage prior to sailing should be reported before launching.
- 3.3. Any new damage should be reported between races or upon pull out.

4. REGATTA FORMAT:

- 4.1. This will be a two fleet (boys and girls), single division event. The two fleets will have separate starts.
- 4.2. Each team will randomly draw their boat assignment at registration.
- 4.3. Crew substitution is permitted in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

5. ENTRY:

- 5.1. Each MSS venue must notify regatta chair of their expected number of sailors/teams no later than Thursday, May 23rd by 6:30PM.
- 5.2. Spaces are available on a first come, first served basis.
- 5.3. The entry fee (including lunch) is \$20 per sailor. Checks should be made payable to "MSC."
- 5.4. Each high school shall be allowed one free lunch for their coach.

6. SCHEDULE:

0800 - Check in and Registration, rigging following registration & assignment
0900 - Mandatory competitors meeting
0945 - First warning, races will continue throughout the day
1500 - No race shall start after this time
