1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after May 26th on MISSA Website.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors & coaches on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 3.3 Competitors meeting will be presented as a short video sent via email to competitors on Friday May 28th.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 This event is a MISSA Tier #3 regatta, open to MISSA teams in good standing.
- 4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online at <https://registration.sailmpls.org/event/2717>
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees by Friday May 28th at 6:00 PM.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees are as follows: \$15 per sailor
- 5.2 Lunch will not be provided due to COVID-19 restrictions.

6 SCHEDULE

Saturday, May 29th, 2021

9:30 - First Warning. Races will continue throughout the day.

To ensure a safe event for all participants, lunch will not be served during this regatta.

1500 – No race shall start after this time

7 COURSES

7.1 Courses will be set and sailed in accordance with the recommendations set forth in the ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024. Any changes will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.

8 SCORING

8.1 A minimum of three races in each division is required for a regatta to be scored.

8.2 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores, in accordance with ISSA PR.

9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

9.1 Support vessels shall keep clear of the racecourse and only coach from the SI designated area between races.

10 RISK STATEMENT

10.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

12 COVID-19

12.1 Only masked sailors and their coaches are permitted in or around the MSC Boathouse or Docks during the event. Spectators are welcome to view the event from any viewpoint along Bde Maka Ska Pkwy.

12.2 All participants, spectators and coaches must affirm that they have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 and have not knowingly been exposed to anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days.
