NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 ISAF RRS, and will be run in accordance with the 2017-2020 Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules, MISSA supplemental rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of four sailors, between the grades of 7-12.
- Any team comprised of sailors from multiple schools or including 7/8th graders shall mark themselves as a "Mixed Team" both on their entry form and Techscore.
- Schools should make teams comprised of students from the same school whenever possible

3. BOATS:

- Provided Club 420s.
- Any previously existing damage prior to sailing should be reported before launching.
- Any new damage should be reported between races or upon pull out.

4. REGATTA FORMAT:

- This is a MISSA Tier 3 Regatta.
- This will be a two-division regatta without rotations.
- Each team will randomly draw their boat assignment at registration.
- Each team will rotate their A and B division into that boat.

5. ENTRY:

- Each MSS venue must notify regatta chair of their expected number of sailors/teams no later than Thursday, April 25th by 6:30PM.
- Spaces are available on a first come, first served basis.
- The entry fee (including lunch) is \$20 per sailor. Make checks payable to "WBSS".
- Each high school shall be allowed one free lunch for their coach.

6. SCHEDULE:

0800 - Check in and Registration, rigging following registration & assignment
0900 - Mandatory competitors meeting
0945 - First warning, races will continue throughout the day
1500 - No race shall start after this time
