Notice of Race (NOR)

1 RULES

1.1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, and Appendix D, which applies in full.

1.1.2 The ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024 available at <https://hssailing.org/documents/ISSA-PR-2021-2024.pdf>, as modified by this NOR apply.

1.1.3 The MISSA Supplemental Rules available at <https://missa.hssailing.org/about/missa-district-rules> apply.

1.2 This is a Team Racing event as per ISSA PR12 and Appendix 6.

1.3 ISSA Appendix 7 does not apply in any way. Actions in this section are completely replaced by RRS Appendix D, as modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 12.

1.4 Races will be umpired according to RRS D2.

1.5 In accordance with the US Sailing Prescription to RRS 70.5 and ISSA PR 20, the right to appeal is denied for this event.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available after May 5th at 1200.

3 COMMUNICATION

3.1 The online official notice board is located at <https://scores.hssailing.org/s21/minnesota-conference/>.

3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors &

coaches on VHF radio. The channel will be stated in the SIs.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 This event is a MISSA Tier #3 regatta, open to competitors from registered MISSA West League Schools in good standing, including 7&8th graders meeting MISSA Supplemental Rules.

4.2 Boats may enter the event by registering online at <https://scores.hssailing.org/s21/minnesota-conference/>

4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees by May 7th, 1700

4.5 A team shall have no fewer than six sailors

5 FEES

5.1 Entry fees are as follows: \$60.00/team

5.2 Lunch is not provided and must be brought by sailors

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the day is 1000

6.2 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made 1700

7 COURSES

7.1 Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSAPR 7.7 and Appendix 6 (Digital N).

8 SCORING

8.1 The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules..

9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 9.1 Support vessels shall keep clear of the race course and only coach from the SI designated area between races.

10 RISK STATEMENT

- 10.1 RRS 3 states: ‘The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.’ By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

11 PRIZES

- 11.1 Prizes will be given to 1st overall team, 2nd overall team, & 3rd overall team

12 COVID-19

- 12.1 The sailing instructions may specify additional ISSA PR changes that affect the schedule, including (but not limited to): limiting equipment rotations, limiting sailor rotations between divisions, scheduling divisions during separate times, or sailing both divisions concurrently on the water.
- 12.2 Health screenings may be required before entering regatta site
