MOTHER'S DAY REGATTA

RULES: The Regatta will be governed by the 2025-2028 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Procedural Rules of the Interscholastic Sailing Association, sailing instructions, and the MISSA Procedural Rules.

ELIGIBILITY: A team is minimum of 4 and a max of 8 sailors unless single division with minimum of 2 and max of 4. MIXED teams are allowed but must be stated in the team name as MIXED. As a reminder, if you are from the same school, but have a grade 8 sailor, this is also a MIXED team. "8th Grade students approved by the MISSA District Director under MISSA Rule 4.3 may participate in this regatta under ISSA PR 1.2 (c). Approval has been granted." This is a Tier 3 event. Coach boats are needed. You must contact the event chair to register.

FORMAT: If able we will do a single division. Alternate plans will consist of A and B divisions of 420s.

PROTEST: 3 minutes of justice, all decisions are final. Approval has been granted by US Sailing.

Competitors Meeting – 10 am

No race after 2:00 pm unless a race is needed to complete a set or having too much fun .

Lunch and awards at the Sailing Center following the races.

ENTRY FEE: \$30.00 per sailor

The fee includes lunch for all sailors and one coach. Sailors must have a refillable water bottle. Bring snacks for on the water, we plan lunch after all sailing is done unless we do two divisions.
