NOTICE OF RACE

1 - RULES

1.1 – This is a MISSA Tier 3 Regatta and will be governed by the rules defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) 2021 - 2024, ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA By-laws, District rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2 - ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.1 - All High School Varsity and Junior Varsity teams are welcome. Competitors must be grades 7-12. Membership in MISSA and ISSA is required.

2.2 - Teams comprised of members from multiple schools are eligible. A school may enter two teams initially; however, there will only be room for 20 teams. If there are open berths by November 6th, schools will be allowed to enter additional teams in the order by which they registered.

2.3 - Eligible schools and sailors enter by registering on Eventbrite.

2.4 - The entry deadline is Friday, November 5th, at noon.

2.5 - The regatta will consist of A and B divisions of 420's (no traps, mainsheet bridles or spinnakers). The regatta will be a round robin format, 420 divisions will rotate boats after every two races.

A full team shall be comprised of a skipper and crew for A division; and a skipper and crew for B division. Alternates optional.

2.6 - Scoring will be in TechScore and you must be active in the system.

3 - FEES

The entry fee is \$35 per competitor plus Eventbrite fees. It includes a grab-and-go breakfast (fruit, yogurt, muffins) and lunch for all sailors and one coach. Extra lunches will be available for purchase at the event for \$10.

We hope to have the traditional turkey dinner with all the fixings at next year's regatta!

4 - BOATS

4.1 – GHHS / SLHS have enough boats for the first 10 teams. We would like to have more boats available. Teams in berths 11 – 20 will need to bring boats.

6 – SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Will be available on Tech Score and at registration

7 – RACING AREA

If conditions allow, will be the portion of Spring Lake immediately in front of SLYC to facilitate prime spectating opportunity.

8 – COURSES

Will be in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules (PR).

9 – SCORING

9.1 – Scoring will be done in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules

9.2 – All completed races will be counted

9.3 – Breakdown points will not be awarded

10 – COACHING

10.1 – All coaches shall be registered in accordance with MISSA By-Laws, Section 3 “Registration – Coaches”.

10.2 – Team-leaders, chaperones, advisors, and coaches and other support personnel are welcome to coach between races. Cheering and noisemakers are highly encouraged.

11 – AWARDS

Winners will be announced.

12 – SAFETY

13.1 - While afloat, competitors must wear US Coast Guard Type III or Type V PFDs and these must be worn OUTSIDE all apparel (including but not limited to splash guards and drysuits) except sleeveless rash guards or school team pinnies used to prevent snags in rigging or improve team/school identification.

13.2 – Every power boat afloat is a safety boat and will assist sailors when needed.
