Notice of Race

RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the 2025-2028 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Procedural Rules of the Interscholastic Sailing Association, the MISSA Procedural Rules, and this notice of race and sailing instructions.

ENTRIES

A team may consist of a minimum of 4 and maximum of 8 students. This is a modified Tier 3 event. Mixed teams are allowed under MISSA Rule 4.4. This changes ISSA PR 1.2 (g). Approval has been granted.

The registration fee is \$30 per sailor for teams outside the Foundry.

CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it takes effect. Other changes may be made to expedite the running of the regatta if all teams are notified before the race in which the change will take effect.

FORMAT

This regatta will consist of A and B divisions of E 420s. Rotations will occur on the water.

0800 Check In/Rigging of boats

0900 Mandatory Competitors Meeting

0945 First Warning Signal

1230 Lunch will be available

No race will start after 1500 with awards following racing.

SAFETY

Personal Flotation Devices must be worn in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule 2.2.

Drysuits will be required if the combined air and water temperature is below 100 degrees Fahrenheit

SCORING

Scoring will be in accordance with ISSA PR 9.

COACHING

Coaches will be responsible for rotation of their teams. Coaches should plan on providing their own boats. A boat ramp is available at the venue.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for the top 3 A, B, and overall teams.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
