1 - RULES

1.1. The regatta will be run in accordance with the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, as well as the Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules, MISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2 – SCHEDULE:

Saturday, May 12, 2018

0800 - Check in and registration, rig boats. Continental Breakfast.

0930 - Competitors Meeting—MANDATORY

1015 - First warning. Races will continue through the day.

Sunday, May 13, 2018

0800 – Continental Breakfast, Rig Boats

0930 - Warning signal for first race

1530 - No race will start after this time - Awards Presentation to follow.

3 – CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 30 minutes before the warning signal of each day on the Official Notice Board located on the window nearest the registration table.

4 – SAFETY

4.1 USCG Approved Type III PFDs are to be worn at all times- shore to shore. Anyone not wearing a USCG Approved Type III PFD will be protested by the Race Committee.

5 – ELIGIBILITY

- . 5.1 Mixed teams will be able to participate. However, full A/B teams will be given preference.
- . 5.2 Sailors must currently be enrolled in grades 8-12 and registered as part of a team in the ISSA database.
- . 5.3 A “Team” is comprised of a minimum of four, maximum of eight, sailors.
- . 5.4 All teams must be current, active members of MISSA and ISSA.

6 – ENTRY AND COMMUNICATION

6.1 Team leaders of eligible schools must email a roster of each team they intend to bring to the event, including sailor name, school, and graduation year, to the Regatta Chair at sailplss@gmail.com prior to May 5 at 5:00pm CST.

6.2 A team is only registered upon confirmation that their team roster has been received by the Regatta Chair. Team leaders will receive confirmation of their registration based on these requirements. All sailors must bring checks or cash for registration to regatta check-in.

- . 6.3 Each team shall submit a Damage Deposit for \$250.00 at check-in on the first day of racing. Checks should be made payable to MYST. In the event that damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided equally between all the teams competing.
- . 6.4 A link to the regatta's registration form will be available on the MYST website at www.sailplss.org/high-school-sailing-myst. Payment (\$45.00/sailor) will be collected at the regatta site prior to racing on Saturday, May 12.

7 – BOATS

- . 7.1 All competitors will sail Collegiate 420s. PLSS/MYST have a limited number of boats for use during the event. Nearby teams will likely need to supply a 420 for each team they bring. Team leaders must request a 420 for their team to use by emailing the Regatta Chair at sailplss@gmail.com. **TEAMS WILL BE LIMITED TO 1 CHARTER BOAT/SCHOOL.MULTIPLE TEAMS FROM THE SAME SCHOOL ARE ALLOWED, BUT MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN BOATS BEYOND 1 CHARTER.** We will work with area clubs to supply additional charters, you may be asked to bring multiple boats.
- . 7.2 Coaches for the regatta will be expected to bring a powerboat capable of rotating their sailors on the water.

8 – COURSES

- . 8.1 Race time may exceed 20 minutes due to the number of participants, thus changing ISSA Procedural Rule 7.7(b)
- . 8.2 The courses will be Windward/Leeward format. L2 and L4 courses will be used to signify downwind finishes, 2 and 4 legs total respectively.
- . 8.3 All marks will be large, bright orange inflatable buoys.
- . 8.4 Starting sequence shall be 3-minute dinghy starts per RRS Appendix S.

9 – PROTESTS

9.1 Protest procedure will be using 3 minute justice system 9.2 Protests must be filed no later than 30 minutes after the RC signal boat has docked. Dock time will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

10 – SCORING

10.1 Scoring will be prescribed by the ISSA Procedural Rules 9 10.2 All completed races shall be counted; there will be no throw-outs 10.3 A minimum of one race in each division is required for the regatta to be official

11 – COACHING

11.1 All coaches shall be registered in accordance with MISSA By-Laws, Article III C, Section 3 “Registration – Coaches” and must be on the team roster prior to May 12, 2017.

11.2 Coaches may go afloat in the starting area so long as they stay a minimum of 100 yards from the racing area at all times and not communicate with participants at any time during racing.

11.3 It is the responsibility of the coaches to withdraw their competitor should the conditions exceed the limitations of the sailor.

12 – PRIZES

12.1 Prizes will be given for 1st-3rd place in each division and overall

13 – HOUSING

13.1 Limited housing is available. Teams who would like to stay with local families must advise Housing Chair, Sarah Spencer sarahspencer@me.com or 414-254 9191 before May 1 @ 5PM

14 – FOOD AND BEVERAGES

14.1 Breakfast and lunch will be provided for the sailors. Water bottle refill stations will be available on shore and on the water; please bring a refillable water bottle.
