NOTICE OF RACE

1 - RULES

1.1 – This is a MISSA Tier 3 Regatta and will be governed by the rules defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) 2017-2020, ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA By-laws, District rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2 - ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.1 - All High School Varsity and Junior Varsity teams are welcome. Competitors must be grades 7-12. Membership in MISSA and ISSA is required. Teams must be composed of athletes from the same school and will be between 4 and 6 athletes. Schools may register more than one team; however, there will only be room for 8 teams. Please e-mail springlakesailing@gmail.com to request permission to enter the regatta.

2.2 - Eligible schools and sailors must then enter by registering on Eventbrite. **You will need a password to register.**

2.3 - The SLYC required waiver of liability should be printed and turned in prior to the start of the event.

2.4 - The entry deadline is Friday, October 2, 2020, at noon.

2.5 - The regatta will consist of A and B divisions of 420's (no traps, mainsheet bridles or spinnakers). Each team will go through a blind draw for boat assignments at the skippers' meeting. The teams will remain in that boat for the duration of the regatta.

2.6 - Scoring will be in TechScore and you must be active in the system.

3 - FEES

The entry fee is \$20 per competitor. There is no food service at this regatta.

4 - BOATS

4.1 – SLHSS / GHSS will provide a 420 for each team randomly, as determined by each crew drawing a number.

4.2 - Registration is limited to the first 8 teams.

5 – SCHEDULE

6 – SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – will be available at registration

7 – RACING AREA – if conditions allow, will be the portion of Spring Lake immediately in front of SLYC to facilitate prime spectating opportunity.

8 – COURSES – will be in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules (PR).

9 – SCORING

9.1 – Scoring will be done in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules

9.2 – All completed races will be counted

9.3 – Breakdown points will not be awarded

11 – AWARDS

Winners will be announced.

12 – SAFETY

12.1 - Masks/face coverings: It is required that participants, including coaches, parents, and chaperones, wear a cloth face covering at all times while on the SLYC premises.

12.2– Setting: The regatta will be outdoors, so dress accordingly. The clubhouse is closed, but bathrooms are available. Masks are required to be worn at all times within the bathrooms.

12.3 – The total number of participants, coaches, regatta organizers, and spectators is limited to 100 people. Athletes, coaches, and a chaperone or two only around the docks and waterfront.

I voluntarily agree to assume all the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any illness, injury, liability, claim or expense of any kind, that I or my child(ren) or my guests may experience or incur in connection with my or my child(ren) or my guest's attendance at the Club or participation in Club programs or activities ("Claim").

Where possible, SLYC has and will continue to implement policies intended to reduce the potential for the spread of COVID-19, but cannot guarantee that you, your household, members of your family, or your guests will not become infected with COVID-19 as a result of sailing at or attending SLYC. Further, sailing at or attending SLYC could increase your risk, and therefore family members' and persons within your household's risk, of contracting COVID-19. Finally, SLYC requires all patrons who voluntarily choose to sail and engage in any sailing related activities to adhere to all local, state and federal regulations regarding social distancing.

I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Club, its employees, agents, volunteers and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or related thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claim based on actions, omissions, or negligence of the Club, its employees, agents, volunteers, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any Club activity or program.
