

Yeah, Buoy! Regatta 2022

Columbia Sailing School

1. RULES

The regatta will be run in accordance with The Racing Rules of Sailing; Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules, MISSA Supplemental Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ENTRY

- 2.1. Entry deadline will be Friday, October 13th at 5 pm. Any team that is entered at this point and later withdraws its entry or fails to show up at the event will be charged the regatta fee in full.
- 2.2. Berths will be assigned on a first come first serve basis; coaches or team leaders please email the teams intent to participate to <u>sail@colyc.org</u> before the October 13 deadline

2.3. <u>Athletes register here.</u>

- 2.4. The entry fee is \$5 per sailor.
- 2.5. A refundable boat damage deposit of \$150 must be submitted with the school's entry. In the event that damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly between all the teams competing. Check should be made payable to "Columbia Sailing School."
- 2.6. Competitors are responsible for bringing their own lunch and refillable water bottles. Spectators and coaches will be allowed to purchase food and drink in the club restaurant and or bar by using a debit/credit card.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. This regatta is open to Central MISSA teams only.
- 3.2. This is a Tier 3 MISSA Event, all MISSA rules apply.
- 3.3. Berths will be given to teams in a first come basis.
- 3.4. Dry suits are required.

4. FORMAT

- 4.1. This will be a 420-A and B fleet regatta with rotations.
- 4.2. 18-420's, boats shall be sailed as provided.

- 1030 Competitors Meeting
- 1100 First Warning

6. COACHES

Each team and individual sailor must come with a coach. The coach is required to have an appropriate boat for rotating all their sailors.

7. PROTEST

A competitor shall not communicate with anyone other than teammates or other competitors before reporting to the race committee an intention to file a protest. Breaking this rule may be grounds for closing the protest hearing.

There will not be trophies for this event.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10. FURTHER INFORMATION

- 10.1. Parking will not be available in the Columbia Member lot, please use DuSable Harbor Parking lot. This is a pay-by-the-hour city of Chicago lot, just north and below ours.
- 10.2. Parents, family, and friends are encouraged to use the club facilities and watch the racing.
- 10.3. The regatta will be hosted at the Columbia Sailing School and Columbia Yacht Club, sailing in Monroe Harbor.
