NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES: The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the ISSA and MISSA Procedural Rules and By-Laws except as altered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 sailors who are on an ISSA team roster. Mixed teams (comprised of students from different schools) shall be allowed. However, we would like to encourage schools to make "True" teams first (comprised of students from the same school), then make mixed teams with remaining sailors.

2.2 This is a Tier 3 event.

3. BOATS:

3.1 Club 420s. The first twelve teams to notify SCSS shall have boats provided by SCSS. After twelve boats have been claimed, teams shall bring their own Club 420.

3.2 Boats will be checked in and out upon launch and pullout. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races or upon pull out.

4. REGATTA FORMAT: This will be a two-division regatta without rotations. Each team will randomly draw their boat assignment at registration. Each team will rotate their A and B division into that boat.

5. ENTRY:

5.1 Each team must notify SCSS (651.895.4291) or director@saintcroixsailingschool.org of the number of sailors they expect to bring no later than Wednesday, April 17th by 6:30PM.

5.2 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. The fee includes registration and lunch on Saturday. Checks should be made payable to "SCSS."

5.3 Each sailing school/community sailing center shall be allowed one free lunch for their coach.

5.4 Additional meal plans for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5 and these requests should accompany that team's entry form.

6. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, April 20th 2019

0800- Check in and Registration

0800-0900- Rigging of boats

0900- Competitors meeting mandatory for all sailors

0945- First Warning, races will continue throughout the day. Lunch will be served on shore between sets

1500- No race shall start after this time.

8. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

8.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

9. WAIVER OF LIABILITY

9.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

9.2 The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

10. LOCATION AND PARKING

10.1 Parking WILL NOT be permitted at the Lakefront Park boat landing lot unless coaches or spectators bring their own boat. If spectators plan to bring a boat, there is a \$12 fee (cash or check) for parking at the Lakefront Park boat landing lot. All other vehicles are to park on city streets in accordance with city parking signs. All parking meters are free on Saturdays. Failure to adhere to the parking rules may result in vehicles being ticked and towed at owner's expense. SCSS is not responsible for any vehicles that are ticked and towed as a result of not following the above mentioned parking rules.
