NOTICE OF RACE

Final –

1 – RULES –

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The Official ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA Procedural Rules and District Rules will apply.

2 – ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY –

- 2.1 - All High School Varsity and Junior Varsity teams are welcome. Eligible competitor shall be enrolled full-time in grades 7 through 12. This is a Tier 3 regatta. Membership in MISSA is required. Teams comprised of members from multiple schools are eligible and partial teams are allowed.
- 2.2 - The entry deadline is **OCTOBER 14, 2021 by 5 pm.**
- 2.3 - An “A” division & “B” division team shall consist of a skipper and crew. Teams must be minimum of 4 sailors with a maximum of 8 sailors per team. A school may enter 2 teams. More spots may be assigned as can be accommodated. This will be a 2-Division rotating regatta. Maximum of 21 A/B teams.

3 – FEES AND REGISTRATION –

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$20 per competitor.
- 3.2 **Eligible schools and sailors must enter by registering online at Eventbrite**

4 – BOATS –

- 4.1 – TACS will provide 21 420’s for schools / teams to share
- 4.2 - No equipment other than screwdrivers, pliers, tape, telltales, bailers, snack bars, and drinking water may be carried during the regatta.

5 – SCHEDULE –

Saturday

Time:

- 09:30 check in, Cornwell Sailing Center (traverse area community sailing)
- 10:15 competitors meeting (on the dock outside pavilion)
- 10:57 first warning signal
- 14:30 No warning signal after this time

- 6 **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** – will be POSTED ON WHITE BOARD in the boathouse at the base of the stairs.
- 7 – **VENUE** – The venue will be at Cornwell Sailing Center on Boardman Lake near downtown Traverse City.
- 8 – **COURSES** – will be in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules (PR). **(W4 with offset and gate)**
- 9 – **SCORING** –
 - 9.1 - Scoring will be done in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules
 - 9.2 - All completed races will be counted.
 - 9.3 - Breakdown points will not be awarded.
- 10 - **SUPPORT BOATS** —coaches may bring a boat to help rotate as the course will be toward the south end of the lake so as to no interfere with the Laser championships. There is a very nice viewing area from down the lake trail on the east side.
- 11 - **RADIO COMMUNICATION** — Except in an emergency, entrants shall not make or receive radio communications while on the water. This applies to cellular phones.
- 12 - **PRIZES** – will be awarded to teams placing 1st place in each division and overall.
- 13 - **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY** — Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
