Format: There will be a single round robin for all 8 teams to establish seeding, followed by double round robins for Gold (1-4) and Silver (5-8) fleets. Wins in later rounds will carry more weight.

Boats: Turbo 420s. There will be no boat rotations.

Rules: ALL ISSA procedural rules will apply EXCEPT for team and sailor eligibility rules, which are modified as follows: This event is open to any high school team, including conglomerate teams, at the discretion of the host.

Registration: Please register by emailing the Event Chair with the following information:

Registration is open until May 19. Registration is on a first come first serve basis and priority will be given to teams registered with NESSA. A wait-list will be assembled if the event becomes full.

Safety: Drysuits are recommended but not required. Face coverings and USCG Approved Type III PFDs are mandatory for all competitors.

Waiver of Liability: Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host organization, sponsors or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property, or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by the law.

Right to Use Name and Likeness: By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

Food: All sailors should bring a reusable water bottle and bagged lunch.

Parking: Unfortunately, SailMaine does not have parking. Street parking in Portland is free on Sundays and there are plenty of spots available within a 5-10 minute walk.
