Notice of Race

Description

The MA State Open High School Sailing Champs will be held in a standard A and B division format, one fleet racing at a time. The event will be sailed in Club 420s provided by Milton Academy and Boston College High School out at Milton Academy's sailing venue in Marina Bay Quincy, MA. on Wednesday and Thursday, May 23-24, 2018.

Eligibility

Any Massachusetts High School group of students may compete in this championship whether or not they have received prior permission or recognition from their school. The school doesn't have to be a member of any league and the competitors are not required to have been granted official permission from their high school in order to participate. All it takes is 2 skippers and 2 crews who know how to swim and will bring their own lifejackets, telltales, bailing buckets, and helmets. Registration shall not be limited. However electronic registration must be completed prior to Wednesday, May 23 at 00:01.

Registration

Registration will be limited to the **first 18 Teams** to electronically register through the above Google Docs form. A minimum of 12 teams must complete registration prior to the deadline.

SAFETY-

All competitors are required to bring their own U.S. Coast Guard Approved lifejackets, bailing buckets, and helmets. A bicycle helmet will suffice as long it has an operable chin strap and is secured while sailing.

Format and Schedule

Racing will be held in Club 420s for A Division and B Division at the Milton Academy Sailing Site on Wednesday, May, 23. Report time is 1 pm. This is the time to show up, NOT the time of the first race. No races will start after 1730 and three races in both divisions must be completed in order to become an official regatta.

Entry Fees

Entry fee is \$30 per team. Payments will be collected at the sailing venue cash or checks only. are possible by checks (payable to "Boston College High School Sailing) or Cash. Receipts will be available for those who need them. Pre-registration is necessary as we need to organize the semi final rounds.

Parking and Transportation
