- 15.1 By participation in racing, a sailor acknowledges that he or she is solely responsible for his or her own safety and that of the crew and boat; that he or she represents that the boat and its equipment are in sound condition and all required safety equipment is aboard, accessible for use and in operable condition; that the decision to race, not to race or to withdraw after starting is solely his or hers; and he or she hereby releases to the fullest extent permitted by law, the organizing authorities, their officers, trustees and all members of the Race Committee, whether or not members of the organizing authorities, from any and all liability or claims for personal injury or property damage resulting from participation in this event.
