NOTICE OF RACE



1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. (available at Registration)
- 1.2. In accordance with RRS rule 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted.
- 1.3. ISSA PR 5.1 (Conduct) shall be in effect for the entire regatta.
- 1.4. The Organizing Authority (OA) is Roger Williams University in conjunction with ISSA.
- 1.5. ISSA PR 2.5 (Team Uniforms/Pinnies) shall be in effect for the entire regatta.

2. ELIGIBILITY: Competing schools must be members of **ISSA & NESSA** and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules, Part III 1, and 5.2. Membership must be active before completing the registration process.

3. ENTRY PROCEDURES & REGATTA FEES.

- 3.1. Schools will apply by filling out the [online registration](#) by September 14, 2018.
- 3.2. A list of selected schools will be published on September 17 with the remaining schools put on a wait list. Any open berths will be filled by teams on the wait list.
- 3.3. Although every attempt will be made to distribute berths to each conference, it will be at the sole discretion of the OA to select teams for this event.
- 3.4. Regatta fee for this event is \$60 payable at the regatta site or via Venmo to Amanda Callahan (@Amanda-Callahan-16). When sending money, please include "RWU Girls Intersectional - your team name" in the memo.

4. BOATS: FJs provided by RWU. Boats will be sailed as provided.

6. RACING AREA: The Race Area will Mt. Hope Bay in front of the Bready Sailing Center.

7. SCORING: The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

8. COACHING:

- 8.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from the time they arrive at the regatta site until the regatta is done unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.
- 8.2. A coach who is also acting as a Race Committee is exempt from 9.1 between sets of races.
- 8.3. ISSA PR 8 defines other coaching limitations and obligations.

9. PRIZES: Prizes will be awards to the first, second, and third place schools

10. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

11. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

13.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

13.2 The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
