Notice of Race

1. HOST

The event will be hosted by Sail Sand Point and the University of Washington Sailing Team.

2. DATES

Saturday the 10th through Sunday the 11th of October 2015

3. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current ISSA\ICSA Procedural Rules, the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.

4. FORMAT AND ELIGIBILITY

All NWISA and NWICSA sailors are eligible to compete. For high school sailors this is the first of three "10%" qualifying fleet race regattas prior to the District Championship. High School and Collegiate Sailors will compete on the same course, but with separate starts for each fleet, in an A/B division fleet racing format.

This regatta is a great opportunity for HS sailors to interact with the NWICSA teams and learn about their programs and college sailing in the NW in general. College team leaders plan to give a 5-minute presentation about your team during the college sailing forum.

5. ENTRY FEE

Entry fee for High School sailors is \$15/sailor: entry will include lunches Saturday and Sunday and snacks during the forum. There is no entry fee for college sailors. College sailors and parents can purchase lunch tickets for \$5 while supplies last.

A \$150 damage deposit will be collect from each High School team (or affiliated organization). Make checks payable to "Sail Sand Point."

7. BOATS

This regatta will be sailed in FJs. Boats will be shared between teams in a rotational format for High School. Sail Sand Point boats are being split between host teams, and HS and College teams so boat availability at the host venue will be VERY limited. All teams able to bring FJs should!
