NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, including Appendix D, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Limited umpiring will be used (see rule D2.6 in Appendix D).
- 1.3. The US Sailing prescriptions to rule 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted and will not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. Competing schools shall be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 2.2. Teams shall be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.3. Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 6 sailors. Multiple teams per school are allowed (limited by boat availability). Teams with less than 6 sailors should contact the regatta chair for help combining with another school.
- 2.4. Team must have a damage deposit on file with NWSA.
- 2.5. Sailors shall be from the NORTH region as designated below:



Schools wishing to compete but are not on this list shall notify the regatta chair for their appropriate region. SOUTH region contact is Sarah Hanavan, oyhighschoolsailing@gmail.com, NORTH region contact Scott Wilson, scottjwilson@gmail.com.

3. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE:

- 3.1. Eligible schools shall register at nwisa.hssailing.org. Registration is on a first come, first served basis. Registration opens April 10th, 2017 at 1100. Registration closes April 17, 2017 at 2200.
- 3.2. Teams unable to compete after registration closes shall notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.
- 3.3. There is no entry fee. Nothing will be provided except for awesome racing!

4. BOATS:

- 4.1. FJs and Vanguard 420s
- 4.2. OYC will provide a Flight of 420s; and currently we have half a flight of FJs (3) but a full set of FJ team racing sails

5. SCHEDULE:

Saturday, April 22, 2017

0900 – 1000 Launch boats at Swantown Marina. Get towed over to Port Plaza Dock.

1000 Mandatory Competitors Meeting at Port Plaza.

1030 First warning; sailing will continue throughout the day.

6. LAUNCHING AREA:

Teams bringing boats are to launch them at the Swantown Marina boat ramp next to the OAR boathouse (where we've launched boats at previous regattas). Address:

7. RACING AREA:

Racing will take place at Port Plaza, using the Port Plaza dock to rotate off of. Address:

701 Columbia St NW, Olympia, WA 98501

Parking and public restrooms are located directly behind Anthony's Restaurant.

8. COACHING:

Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Saturday morning to the end of racing Sunday unless an exception has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

9. CONDUCT

- 9.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841.
- 9.2. Infringements of this regulation and/or other inappropriate conduct occurring during the regatta, may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall, at a time and place selected by it, meet to hear said protest, and it may impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions that it deems appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta.
