1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, the ISSA Procedural Rules, and the NWISA District Rules, However,

1.1.1.the US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, and 63.4 will not be in effect; and

1.1.2.under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 Current ISSA and NWISA membership is required and will be verified at the time of final registration at the regatta site.

2.2 A responsible adult leader must accompany teams at all times

2.3 Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 8 sailors who are full time students in the 9th grade or higher, attending the same high school.

2.4 There are no numerical or age restrictions, or school restrictions on junior varsity (“silver fleet”) competitors.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS

3.1 Eligible schools shall register through the NWISA website link. Registration is on a first come, first served if berths are limited. Registration opens 2-18-19 at 1100.

3.2 Registration closes 2-25-19 at 2200. Additional registrations are allowed after this time, but teams may be turned away if event capacity is reached.

3.3 Teams unable to compete shall notify the Regatta Chair as soon as possible.

3.4 Each competing program must have a damage deposit on file with NWISA per District rule 7.3.

3.5 Entry fee

1130 First Warning: Racing will continue throughout the day.

Eat during boat rotation – no lunch break (no lunch provided).

Racing will continue until late, weather permitting and daylight permitting.

1700 No Starts after this time

Any changes to the schedule will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

6. RACING AREA

6.1 The racing area will Fidalgo Bay.

6.2 Rotations for both fleets will be located on the floating dock at Seafarers Memorial Park.

7. COURSES

7.1 Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses. Short collegiate style courses will be used.

8. SCORING

8.1 The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. FORMAT

9.1 The format will consist of two races in A division, followed by boat rotation, and two races in B division.

10. TRAVEL

10.1 Teams are responsible for their own transportation. The address of the regatta is 601 Seafarers Way, Anacortes Wa, 98221. Directions to the racing venue are: From westbound state route 20 Spur, exit onto R ave at the traffic light entering the city of Anacortes. Proceed north on R ave to right turn (east) onto Seafarers Way. Continue straight toward the water until trending right toward the park building. After unload, Trailer parking is available at the corner of R and Seafarers Way.

11. COACHING

11.1 Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from the start of racing Saturday to the end of racing Sunday UNLESS an exception has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair or PRO.

11.2 Competitors may receive coaching including instructions, assistance, equipment or sustenance only while on the designated rotation float or on shore.

12. OFFICIAL NOTICE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

12.1 No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, distilled spirits), or use any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.), the possession of which is unlawful. An alleged breach of this rule and/or other disciplinary matters that occur may be the basis for a hearing under rule 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing will be the Regatta Chairperson, a member of the NWISA Board of Directors and the chairperson of the protest committee.
