

**Notice of Race**  
**2016 Olympia 10% Regatta**  
**OYC High School Sailing, Olympia Washington**  
**October 22-23rd, 2016**

1. HOST

1.1. This regatta is hosted by the Olympia Yacht Club High School Sailing Team, OYC Junior Program, Swantown Marina and The Port of Olympia.

2. RULES

2.1. The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA procedural rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1. This regatta is a Qualifying Regatta as defined by the NWISA District Supplemental Rules. Qualifying regattas may be attended by active or mixed teams. However, final scores by mixed teams or additional active teams (JV teams) will be removed from the official results and the regatta will be re-scored. For schools sending multiple Active teams, a Varsity team must be designated at registration. This Varsity team will be the team scored in the overall rankings for our Double-handed Fleet Race District Championship.

3.2. Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 4 sailors. Multiple teams per school are allowed (limited by boat availability).

4. FORMAT

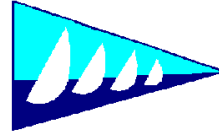
4.1. The regatta will consist of an A and B division and will be sailed with one division on the water at a time.

5. ENTRY FEE & T-SHIRTS

5.1. A \$250 damage deposit will be collected from each High School team (or affiliated organization). Make checks payable to "NWISA." All teams are required to have this damage deposit on file with NWISA.

5.2. Entry fee for High School sailors is \$10/sailor, fee includes:

- Snacks Saturday and Sunday.
- Lunch Saturday for sailors—parents may purchase for \$5 after sailors, as long as supplies last.



- 5.3. T-shirts will be sold *separately*, and are not included in Regatta fee. They are t-shirts from our previous event. Tech long sleeves. Competitors and parents can purchase for \$15; sizes limited.

## 6. VENUE

- 6.1. Racing will take place just north of Swantown Marina and Boatworks (the regatta is **not** at the Olympia Yacht Club). Boats will be launched at the Swantown boat ramp next to the Olympia Area Rowing (OAR) boat house. Viewing, parking, and boat/trailer storage will take place in the upper “viewing” parking lot just north of the OAR boat house and launch ramp.

- 6.2. Access to the parking lot is via Marine Drive, the next right after the OAR boat house and launch ramp entrance. While spectator tents and canopies may be provided, along with some seating and tables, the area is exposed to the weather. Please plan accordingly.
- 6.3. Swantown bathrooms directly across from the OAR boat house may be used during the event.
- 6.4. The Olympia Farmer’s Market is close by with local foods and crafts. Downtown Olympia is only 5 minutes away. Ralph’s Bayview Thriftway is next door to the Olympia Yacht Club and is a good option for grocery shopping close to the race venue.

## 7. BOATS

- 7.1. Boat allocations will be determined based on district supplemental rules boat allocation procedures.
- 7.2. The Regatta will be sailed in FJs. There are no charters available from the OYC.
- 7.3. Silver/JV Fleet in 420s (OYC has 10)

## 8. LAUNCHING & STORAGE

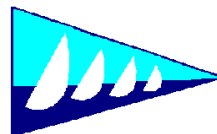
- 8.1. Teams may begin unloading and launching boats prior to the skippers meeting.
- 8.2. Overnight boat storage, trailer parking, and spectator parking are available in the north “viewing” parking lot, more details will be shared at the Skippers Meeting.

## 9. SKIPPERS MEETING & CHECK-IN

- 9.1. The Skippers Meeting will take place near the launch ramps.
- 9.2. Check-in will be under the large canopies next to the OAR boathouse. Regatta Fees and Medical/Liability waivers will be collected.

## 10. REGISTRATION

- 10.1. Registration opens October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016. Eligible schools shall submit their intent to participate, total number of sailors attending and number of boats they can bring to the NWISA registration spreadsheet no later than October 17<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at 10:00pm. Additional



registrations are allowed after this time, but teams may be turned away if boats are unavailable. There will be no morning of registration.

- 10.2. Please print, and fill out our Medical/Liability waivers for each participating sailor and turn in during check-in with regatta fees.
