





Olympia Team Race Regatta April 7-8th, 2019 Olympia, WA

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, including Appendix D, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the NWISA District Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Limited umpiring will be used per rule D2.6.
- 1.3. The US Sailing prescriptions to rule 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted and will not apply.
- 1.4. Under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

- 2.1. Competing schools shall be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 2.2. Teams shall be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.3. Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 6 sailors. Multiple teams per school are allowed (limited by boat availability). Teams with less than 6 sailors should contact the regatta chair for help combining with another school.
- 2.4. Each competitor must have a signed EVENT WAIVER on file (ATTACHED).
- 2.5. Team must have a damage deposit on file with NWISA.

3. ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE:

- 3.1. Eligible schools shall register at nwisa.hssailing.org. Registration is on a first come, first served basis. Registration opens March 26th at 1100. Registration closes April 2nd at 2200.
- 3.2. The regatta will be limited to the first 12 teams registered after

registration opens. Registration priority will be given as follows:

- 1. Host Active Schools
- 2. Varsity Active Schools (1st team)
- 3. Program Mixed 1st Teams
- 4. JV Active Schools (2nd or 3rd teams)
- 5. Program Mixed 2nd or 3rd teams
- 3.3. Teams will be separated into 2 fleets: Gold and Silver. Seeding will be based on Regional Team Race scores.
- 3.4. Teams unable to compete after registration closes shall notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.
- 3.5. Entry fee is \$10. Snacks and drinks will be provided both days. Breakfast will be provided Sunday morning at the Olympia Yacht Club.

4. BOATS:

- 4.1. FJs and Vanguard 420s
- 4.2. OYC will provide a Flight of 420s (6); and a flight of FJs (6).

5. SCHEDULE:

0900 Launch boats at Swantown

6. LAUNCHING AREA:

Teams bringing boats are to launch them at the Swantown Marina boat ramp next to the OAR boathouse (where we've launched boats at previous regattas). Address:

7. RACING AREA:

Racing will take place at Port Plaza, using the Port Plaza dock to rotate off of. Address:

701 Columbia St NW, Olympia, WA 98501

Parking and public restrooms are located directly behind Anthony's Restaurant.

8. COACHING:

Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Saturday morning to the end of racing Sunday unless an exception has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

9. CONDUCT

- 9.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841.
- 9.2. Infringements of this regulation and/or other inappropriate conduct occurring during the regatta, may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing shall, at a time and place selected by it, meet to hear said protest, and it may impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions that it deems appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta.
