



Port Angeles Open Regatta

April 13-14, 2019

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, and the NWISA District Rules, however:
- 1.2. The US Sailing prescriptions to rule 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted and will not apply.
- 1.3. Under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied.
- 1.4. Each program must have a damage deposit on file with NWISA per District rule 7.3.
- 1.5. Competitors shall wear a USCG approved Type III PFD at all times while afloat.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1. This is an 'Open Regatta' as described in the NWISA District Rules. 'Active' and 'Mixed' teams may attend. Team shall be registered with NWISA and ISSA including online registration, team fees paid, and damage deposit paid.
- 2.2. Teams shall be comprised of a minimum of 4 sailors. Multiple teams per school are allowed (limited by boat availability).
- 2.3. Teams shall be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.4. Eligible schools shall register through the NWISA website link. Registration is on a first come, first served if berths are limited. Registration opens Monday, April. 1 at 1100 hrs.
- 2.5. Registration closes at 2200 April 8th. Additional registrations are allowed after this time, but teams may be turned away if event capacity is reached.
- 2.6. Teams unable to compete once registration closes, shall notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.

3. ENTRY FEE & FOOD

An entry fee of \$20 per team will be collected at registration on Saturday morning. A light breakfast and hot lunch will be provided on both Saturday and Sunday. There will be a limited number of additional meal tickets are available for adults at a cost of \$5 per day.

4. VENUE

Racing will take place in Port Angeles Harbor. Competitor's meeting, registration, and meals will take place at Port Angeles Yacht Club located at **1305 Marine Dr, Port Angeles, WA 98363**. PAYC will also be open for spectating throughout the weekend and offers excellent views of the race course. Parking for cars and trailers will be available in a specially designated area of the marina parking lot. (See "Attachment A" for map of venue)

5. BOATS & FORMAT

The regatta will be sailed in FJs. Teams are encouraged to bring boats with them. Those unable to do so may request a boat on the registration spreadsheet. This will be a rotational event following the standard A/B fleet-racing format. Launching and rotations shall take place at the public boat launch located immediately next to Port Angeles Yacht Club.
