

Portland Team Race April 6-7th, 2019 Willamette Sailing Club Portland, OR



1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix D, the ISSA Procedural Rules, and the NWISA District Rules.
- 1.2 Limited umpiring will be used (see rule D2.6 in Appendix D).
- 1.3 The US Sailing prescriptions to rule 60, 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted and will not apply.
- 1.4 Under rule 70.5(a), the right of appeal is denied.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Current ISSA and NWISA membership is required and will be verified at the time of final registration at the regatta site.
- 2.2 A maximum of 12 teams will be accepted. Registration is on a first come, first served basis.
- 2.3 A responsible adult leader must accompany teams at all times
- 2.4 A varsity team ("gold fleet") shall consist of a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 9 sailors who are full time students in the 9th grade or higher, attending the same high school. There is only a gold fleet and only active teams as defined in the NWISA District Rules are eligible.
- 2.5 Teams shall have a damage deposit on file with NWISA.
- 2.6 Sailors shall be from the SOUTH region.

Schools not clear on which region they belong to should contact NWISA President - Scott Wilson, <u>scottjwilson@gmail.com</u>.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 Eligible schools shall register at nwisa.hssailing.org. Registration is on a first come, first served basis. Registration opens March 25, 2019 at 1100. <u>Registration closes</u> April 1, 2019 at 2200.
- 3.2 Teams unable to compete shall notify the Regatta Chair as soon as possible.

3.3 Entry fee includes a BBQ Lunch both days

Entry Fee: \$20 per person Competing teams must have a damage deposit on file with NWISA

5. RACING AREA

- 5.1 The racing area will east of the Willamette Sailing Club Sailing Facility.
- 5.2 Rotations for both fleets will be on the dock immediately south of the Sailing Facility.

6. COURSES

6.1 Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR Appendix 6.

7. SCORING

7.1 The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

8. LODGING

- 8.1 Housing is available, contact Michael Cornew @ headcoach@willamettesailingclub.com
- 8.2 You must provide your own sleeping bag and pillow.

8.3 Each team is responsible for supervising their sailors at all times during the regatta and while at provided housing.

10. COACHING

- 10.1 Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from the start of racing Saturday to the end of racing Sunday UNLESS an exception has been explicitly permitted by the regatta chair or PRO.
- 10.2 Competitors may receive coaching including instructions, assistance, equipment or sustenance only while on the designated rotation float or on shore.

11.1 No Prizes will be awarded

12. OFFICIAL NOTICE FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS

12.1 No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, distilled spirits), or use any controlled substance (marijuana, cocaine, etc.), the possession of which is unlawful. An alleged breach of this rule and/or other disciplinary matters that occur may be the basis for a hearing under rule 69.1. The protest committee for such a hearing will be the Regatta Chairperson, a member of the NWISA Board of Directors and the chairperson of the protest committee.
